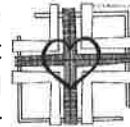

## February 24, 2019 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

### DO NO HARM

We listen quite a while before we get to the "punch line" of the first reading today: even though it would be an easy thing to do, David will not harm the anointed one of the Lord. We, of course, know that Jesus is the Messiah, the anointed one of God, but the Bible uses this term for many different people. It is scripture's way of indicating who has been chosen by God for a special place and mission in salvation history.



In today's Gospel, Jesus presents a greatly enlarged list of those who, as children of God, we should not harm, but love instead: our enemies, those who curse us or do us harm, those who owe us money, the ungrateful, the wicked. The point of Jesus' teaching is not to encourage these kinds of behaviors in others, but rather to form us in the image of our heavenly Father by increasing our opportunities to love unconditionally, expecting no return; to be merciful and forgiving, even when it would be easier not to. *Copyright © J. Thank you for all the positive responses and continuous support. I want to express once again my gratitude to our Sarnia priests for their help in ministering to our churches. I think I speak on behalf of all of us. Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, who celebrated one of the weekend masses last week, expressed his admiration of the parishioner's welcoming attitude and confirmed his dedication in the search for a helping priest for our Parish Community.

It is difficult to believe but Ash Wednesday is just around the corner. It might be a great opportunity to think now about the Lenten resolution and not be caught off-guard later.

To find our resolution we have to understand the meaning of Lent. Therese Mueller likens Lent to spring: *"Spring occupies a very important place in the life of the tiller of the soil; as far as man is concerned, spring decides what the crop will be. Similarly, in the life of grace, Lent holds an almost decisive position. (Lent is but another word for spring). The more carefully we put away the deeds of winter, the 'dead' deeds, the deeper we plow in order that the new seed may find a well-prepared soil enriched with the good deeds of fasting and prayer, the more shall we enjoy the vigorous plants that will spring up and the abundance of the harvest . . . Just as Nature renews herself every spring, so during the Church's spring we are encouraged to begin anew with the catechumens. We prepare for the renewal of our baptism, we suffer with Christ for our sins, we are buried with Him so that we may also arise with Him to a new life of grace and glory"* (Family Life in Christ). Our actions should not just be in giving up something, but also positive actions such as charitable acts and prayer. I will keep you in my prayers that you might find your path through Lent to Easter. To help us in that we have invited Fr. Ben Luedtke who will lead us in our Parish Mission – please mark in your calendars **April 7-10 for our mission**. More details to follow.

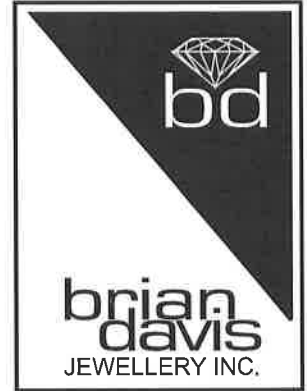
