THE INSIDE SHOWS

In this third Sunday of our reading from the Sermon on the Plain, Jesus speaks of the inner soul and its outer expression. He uses images as he teaches. He addresses all of us.

Jesus sees a plumb line connecting the soul with the soul's expression-words and actions. He uses exaggeration to drive home his point. We are urged to clear out the debris that blinds us. He knows that we have an uncanny ability to be blind to our own weaknesses, though they be as big as a board. He knows, too, how willingly we seem to ferret out others' smallest speck-like flaws.

And this, too, is for our general consumption; solid old goodness and solid old badness will show eventually. The old Latin saying, which echoes Jesus' images, is true: "What is bred in the bone will out in the flesh." By and by, the inside will show through.

Last Sunday Pope Francis closed in the Vatican the summit on the protection of minors in the Church. It took place Feb. 21-24, and included the participation, from around the world, of around 190 presidents of bishops' conferences, heads of Eastern Catholic Churches, and several superiors

general of religious congregations.

The meeting was called in response to the crisis of clergy sexual abuse around the world, with a stated purpose of educating the world's bishops on their responsibility for protecting minors from abuse within the Church.

Pope Francis has outlined eight points that the Church will focus on in an "all-out battle" against the sexual abuse of minors to, "turn this evil into an opportunity for purification."

"Today we find ourselves before a manifestation of brazen, aggressive and destructive evil," he said. "We need to take up the spiritual means that the Lord himself teaches us: humiliation, self-accusation, prayer and penance. This is the only way to overcome the spirit of evil. It is how Jesus himself overcame it."

Building upon the World Health Organization's "Seven Strategies for Ending Violence against Children," the pope presented eight guidelines to aid the Church in "developing her legislation" on the issues.

The eight guidelines can be summarized as follows:

1. A "change of mentality" to focus on protecting children rather than "protecting the institution."
2. A recognition of the "impeccable seriousness" of these "sins and crimes of consecrated persons."
3. A genuine purification beginning with "self-accusation."
4. Positive formation of candidates for the priesthood in the virtue of chastity.
5. Strengthening and reviewing of guidelines by episcopal conferences, reaffirming the need for "rules."
6. The accompaniment of those who have been abused with an emphasis on listening.
7. Ensure that seminarians and clergy are not enslaved to an addiction to pornography.
8. Combat sexual tourism around the world.

On Monday, Feb 25th, in the Vatican's first follow-up to child abuse summit, officials emphasized "encounter" and the need for concrete responses as called for by Catholics.

Organizers outlined for officials the principles behind the forthcoming documents and task forces – the promised outcomes of the abuse summit which were announced Sunday.

The concrete commitments made at the end of the Vatican's sex abuse summit Sunday included the publication of a *motu proprio* from Pope Francis "on the protection of minors and vulnerable persons," Lombardi announced Feb. 24.

Another measure slated to take place over the next months is the creation of task forces specifically to help local Churches in need of help in solving problems and developing initiatives in their bishops' conferences and dioceses. (from Catholic News Agency)

This week we will start Lent with our Ash Wednesday Masses. Please check the schedule on the front cover of the bulletin. We look forward to seeing you take part in our celebrations. Just a reminder it is a day of fasting after the scrumptious Paczkies, Pancakes and Melasades which we eat on Fat (Shrove) Tuesday.



Ash Wednesday - "The act of putting on ashes symbolizes fragility and mortality, and the need to be redeemed by the mercy of God. Far from being a merely external act, the Church has retained the use of ashes to symbolize that attitude of internal penance to which all the baptized are called during Lent (Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy)." The ashes typically come from palms blessed the previous Passion (Palm) Sunday. Please note that all people are welcome to receive ashes. Catholics or none, sinners or saints, young and old. They are a sign of us collectively entering into the Penitential Season of Lent.



Fasting and Abstinence in Lent – Daily we should observe some acts of prayer, fasting and almsgiving (charity). Every Friday in Lent is a day of abstinence. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fasting and abstinence. On Holy Saturday fasting is encouraged.

Abstinence - prohibits the eating of meat, but eggs, milk products, and sauces made from animal fats may be eaten, as may fish and all cold-blooded animals (eg. frogs, clams, turtles). In Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on days of abstinence. The law of abstinence binds those who are 14 years of age and older.

Fasting – only one full meal be taken during the day; two light meals are permitted in accord with local custom as to the amount and kind of food (traditionally the two lighter meals are meant to be of such a size that together they are less than or equal to the one full meal). Consumption of solid foods between meals is also prohibited, however liquids are permitted. The law of fasting binds those who are between 18 and 59 years of age.

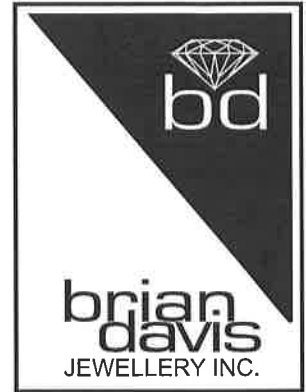
