ALMSGIVING, PRAYER, FASTING, AND TEMPTATION

As we begin our season of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, the reading from Deuteronomy reminds us of our duty of almsgiving, that we "set [our offerings] before the Lord, [our] God, [and] shall bow down in [God's] presence" (Deuteronomy 26:10). The reading from Romans refers us to our prayer, reminding us that "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart... For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved" (Romans 10:8, 13). These are comforting words, and encourage us to ask God for what we need and to aid us in our prayer. Finally, the Gospel of Luke shows us a fasting Jesus, who was tempted as we are, and who knows what it means to be human. Someone once said that temptation arises when you're tired and weary, and the devil comes along and makes a perfectly reasonable suggestion. Jesus shows us that, with his help, we too can overcome our temptations, reasonable as they may sound.

We have begun the Lenten season. As we celebrate the First Sunday of Lent, all over the world, children and adults alike are beginning their preparation for baptism at the Easter Vigil. Please keep them in your prayers. Like them, we begin our own preparations, looking forward to renewing our baptismal vows and being blessed with Easter water.

It is our tradition that we join our Lenten Time with Development and Peace initiative. Last few months were filled with some controversy around the D&P, but letter from our bishop Fabbro (included with the bulletin) explains the steps taken to address our concerns and make sure the resources are used properly. You will find Share the Journey brochure in the bulletin and envelope in your set.

I believe we need some updates on the works around our churches. There is an excess of work to be done.

With the beginning of April, the work on the exterior of Our Lady of Mercy Church will start. You will be able to see the scaffolding rise up. The work to be done includes repointing of the bricks and replacement of the broken ones, taking down the unused chimneys. The work on stain glass window by the London Road will include taking down storm glass that caused the deterioration of the wooden frames and replacing it with new, ventilated one. Unfortunately, we won't be able to clean the bricks, as on the front of the Church, because of the lack of funds – we have not reached the goal in our Capital Campaign.

St. Joseph's main stairs to the Church are to be replaced. The work should start in few weeks. In the meantime, don't worry, the side entrances will help us get inside. The Church is in the middle of the beautification program as well. There is "Adopt a plant" campaign. More details in the future and on the Facebook Page <https://www.facebook.com/StJosephsSarnia/>

St. Benedict's windows are in need of repair. There are a few broken, and we have some problems with weather stripping on the east and west windows. Those issues will be addressed in coming weeks. We are also working on the church's lighting system: it is not functioning properly and some of you were not able to see clearly because of that. **Fr. Mateusz Sobierajski**
