### STAND FIRM IN THE LORD

It is not hard to imagine, in this age of wars, evil groups bent on the destruction of humanity, and political follies, that the words of Saint Paul were so accurate, even for his time. It seems that the world never changes. Paul says, "Many... conduct themselves as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is their destruction... Their minds are occupied with earthly things" (Philippians 3:18, 19). The result is the destruction of innocent people and of the Earth itself. But Paul says to the Philippians, "our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we also await a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ" (3:20). He will "change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (3:21). Note that he says "body" rather than "bodies." He is talking about the whole community of believers, who, following the example of Jesus and of Paul, will come into the glory of God. So "stand firm in the Lord" (4:1). *Copyright © J. S. In 1990, a peaceful community in the south of Nigeria became the victim of what has been recognized

## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Each year the Church enjoys the privilege of celebrating the Rite of Election for those seeking to be baptized. The rite begins their Lenten Retreat — a period of enlightenment and conversion. As well, we invite our candidates for a full communion with the Catholic Church to journey with us in our Lenten renewal, awaiting the renewal of our baptismal promises and their welcome to the Eucharistic table. Each of these groups of sojourners move intensely through the Lenten period with God's grace and our prayerful accompaniment. They, indeed become witnesses for us of the depth that is possible during the Lenten conversion process. This year we have 5 candidates presently journeying through the process of initiation. In order to inspire the elect a desire for purification and redemption by Christ, three scrutinies are celebrated. By this means, first of all, the elect are instructed gradually about the mystery of sin, from which the whole world and every person longs to be delivered and thus saved from its present and future consequences. Second, their spirit is filled with Christ the Redeemer, who is the living water (gospel of the Samaritan woman in the **first scrutiny**), the light of the world (gospel of the man born blind in the **second scrutiny**), the resurrection and life (gospel of Lazarus in the **third scrutiny**). From the first to the final scrutiny the elect should progress in their perception of sin and their desire for salvation.
