
Share the journey with those forcibly displaced in Colombia

This Rose Sunday receives its name from the Entrance Antiphon of the Mass (Laetare Jerusalem! – Rejoice Jerusalem!) which emphasizes the nearness of our salvation. After this Sunday, Lent will increasingly focus on the events of the Passion.

The coming weekend we will host Fr. Ben Luedtke for our Parish Mission (www.godblessya.com). Fr. Ben will begin at the April 6/7 weekend Masses, followed by four talks as follows:

Sunday: 7:30pm at St. Benedict (Topic: Time and Eternity)

Monday: 7pm at St. Joseph (Forgiveness) with the opportunity for Life Confessions

Tuesday: 7pm at St. Benedict (Holy Eucharist) preceded by 6:30pm Holy Mass

Wednesday: 7pm at Our Lady of Mercy (Blessed Virgin Mary and the Cross) with a social to follow.

You will be able to support our missionary with free-will donations using envelopes available at the church entrances.

April 10 is our ‘Day of Confession’. This year will be a little different. All priests from Sarnia will be hearing confessions from 8am until 9pm in two churches: Sacred Heart and Our Lady of Mercy. Confessions will be available in English, French and Polish. Please check times displayed on bulletin boards. As every year, there will also be additional confession times: at St. Joseph (Sat. April 6 from 10am-1pm) and at St. Benedict (Sat. April 13, 12noon – 4:45pm).

Preparation for the Holy Triduum is underway. You can find the schedule in the bulletin. We will need your help, so please be open to volunteering in the Liturgies. We are looking especially for Altar Servers at our three churches.

Just a heads up: we will be using incense at our liturgies on Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil.

Confirmation and First Communion/Reconciliation

Candidates are closing their preparation programs – please keep them and their families in your prayers as they are recognizing God’s work in their lives.

After purchasing **altar linens** for St. Benedict, we have decided to replace the used and older linens at St. Joseph and Our Lady of Mercy. Two sets (for feasts and everyday) have been ordered for 4 altars at St. Joseph (cost \$600), and 2 altars at OLM (\$300), plus side tables for both. We have just experienced our First Scrutiny last Thursday. These very special ancient rites are celebrated in the middle of Lent, at liturgies where the Elect are present.

The Elect are those in our midst who are preparing for Baptism. The Scrutinies are meant to uncover, and then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the Elect; to bring out, and strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. The Scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the Elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life. These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the Elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all. **Please pray for our Elect on their journey in faith and, if you can, please join us for the upcoming Scrutinies on April 4 and 11 at St. Benedict Church during 6:30pm mass.** (Keep in mind that Scrutinies have their own special mass readings).
