GOD'S ACTIONS NOW

When Jews celebrate the Passover, they always tell the story of the Exodus in present terms, as if they themselves experienced those events: when we were prisoners in Egypt; when God brought us out of slavery and through the waters of the sea. We would do well to follow their example and see the works of Jesus and his sacrifice as being in the present, as happening to us now. We believe that Christ's work, his teachings, and his sacrifice on the cross were not just for his followers in the past, but for all people at all times. When we think of this in our prayers, we become one in faith with that great cloud of witnesses, the saints.

We have been striving through Lent to repent of our sins and failings, and to follow Jesus more closely. Today in the story of the woman caught in adultery, we see Jesus forgiving the woman, saving her from a horrible death, and urging her not to sin any more. This is new, and brings out something for which the law had not allowed—forgiveness. Of course one can sin no more if one is dead, caught in one's sins forever. But Jesus introduces the concepts of forgiveness and reconciliation.

My dear parishioners, we do not have luck this year. Father Ben Leudtke called us Monday with the unfortunate news that he cannot come for our Lenten Mission. With so little time and screening process that takes up to a month to complete, we were left without a missionary. **We had to cancel our Lenten Parish Mission this year.**

To compensate for the lack of our missions, we are bringing something new. We all know the great composer **Johan Sebastian Bach**. This great artist was an organist in the churches of Arnstadt, Mühlhausen and Leipzig, among others. He created many musical pieces for those churches to help reflect various religious events. One of his greatest masterpieces is **Passion of Christ according to St. Matthew Gospel**. It is a beautiful oratorio where events from the Gospel interweave with meditations on Jesus' Passion. We have acquired the DVD of the oratorio performed by Amsterdam Baroque Orchestra & Choir with Ton Koopman as the Conductor – one of the best performances of that Passion available. We will screen it **Saturday, 13th of April at Our Lady of Mercy Hall at 7pm**. Be ready for over 2 hours of spiritual meditation. Snacks and drink will be available at the intermission. The Passion is of course in German, but with English subtitles.

Day of Confession throughout the Diocese of London is this Wednesday April 10th. We will have two churches in Sarnia: **Sacred Heart** and **Our Lady of Mercy** with confessions available from **8am until 9pm**. This is the time for all of us to participate in the sacrament of reconciliation, along with our First Reconciliation Children. Fathers: Kathemo Mukucha and Zbigniew Rodzinka are coming to provide confessions in French and Polish, respectively, in addition to English (check details on bulletin boards). Moreover, Confession will be available at St. Benedict on Saturday, April the 13th from 12noon to 4:45pm. (St. Joseph's confessions were April 6th). Be advised that confessions **won't** be available during the Easter Triduum celebrations (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday). For help in preparing for confession visit confession.sarniacatholic.ca

The preparation for the Holy Triduum is underway. You can find the schedule in the bulletin. (Remember there is no evening mass on Easter Sunday). We will need your help, so please be open to volunteering in the Liturgies.

Just a heads up: we will be using incense at our liturgies on Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil.

Projects Update:

At **Our Lady of Mercy** Church the new washroom is under construction. We are hoping to make it available for Easter. The exterior work is underway. One chimney is already down, with two more to be demolished. The next step is the masonry work with replacing the broken bricks and repointing. The wood work outside will follow when the wooden gable decorations will be replaced with maintenance-free metal.

St. Joseph's exterior stair work has finally begun. The broken concrete surface will be replaced with new one. Congratulations on the Beautification Project Fundraiser. We have surpassed the goal. The additional fund will cover equipment rental and protection barriers.

St. Benedict's lights are giving us more and more trouble. The preparatory process to replace them has begun. Unfortunately, we had to schedule the work after Easter to avoid unnecessary disturbances during the celebrations. There is no easy way to access the lightbulbs themselves other than from the bottom or the top of the fixtures.
