Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord April 14, 2019

THE STORY OF OUR REDEMPTION

We begin the final week of Lent with these familiar readings. This year, we hear the Passion from the Gospel of Luke. These readings for Palm Sunday and the Passion used to be read on successive Sundays. Now they are combined into a single feast, so that we may see the whole sweep of the glory and the suffering played out. Jesus accepts the adulation of the crowd, the foreshadowing of his glory in the Resurrection. He bids farewell to his disciples in his last Passover, and forgives his tormentors as he dies on the cross. Later this week, we enter the Holy Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, when the whole story of our redemption will play out once again.

Welcome to this Passion Sunday Mass!!!
We welcome all parishioners and guests! The Easter celebrations are approaching as the great reminder of God's love for us. This message of love Jesus signed with His own blood on the cross, shows that even His life is not as important as we are. I pray that this time of reflection might bring us closer to Him.

Passion (Palm) Sunday

"Jesus enters Jerusalem. The liturgy invites us to share in the joy and celebration of the people who cry out in praise of their Lord; a joy that will fade and leaves a bitter and sorrowful taste by the end of the account of the Passion. This celebration seems to combine stories of joy and suffering, mistakes and successes, which are part of our daily lives as disciples. It somehow expresses the contradictory feelings that we too, the men and women of today, experience: the capacity for great love... but also for great hatred; the capacity for courageous self-sacrifice, but also the ability to "wash our hands" at the right moment; the capacity for loyalty, but also for great abandonment and betrayal. – Pope Francis Palm Sunday, 25 March 2018

- **Holy Thursday, April 18 - the Mass of the Lord's Supper**, charity is one of the central themes of the Mass. This is represented by the washing of the feet.
- **Good Friday, April 19 - a day of fasting and abstaining.** Fasting helps to make the times of self-discipline and penance to better mark the great celebrations of the Church; and to acquire self-mastery over our instincts and freedom of the heart. Fasting means that only one full meal be taken during the day plus two light meals. The law of fasting binds those who are between 18 to 59 years of age.
To help with your Good Friday fasting, the Knights of Columbus are offering a fasting and abstinence soup at each church. Please check the bulletin for times.
- **Holy Saturday - A note regarding Holy Communion during the Triduum.** Outside of the liturgies, Holy Communion may be taken to the sick on Holy Thursday and Good Friday. On Holy Saturday, Communion may be given only as viaticum (for the dying).
- **Easter Vigil, April 20 - the most important celebration of the whole year.** There will be an **8:30pm Mass at Our Lady of Mercy Church**; therefore, there will be **no 5pm or 5:30pm Mass on Holy Saturday.** Though it takes a good couple of hours, it is a very beautiful celebration. Please make a very strong effort to attend!

Incense will be used on Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil.

Did you miss our special Lenten confessions? There are still regular Confessions available half hour before each weekday mass this week Monday to Wednesday.

*My Heart overflows with great mercy for souls, and especially for poor sinners... It is for them that the Blood and Water flowed from My Heart as from a fount overflowing with mercy. For them I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy. (Diary of St. Faustina, 367) Words spoken by Jesus to St. Faustina. **Our Lord desired that the Sunday following Easter be Devine Mercy Sunday. This Year we will gather at St. Michael's Church, Bright's Grove.***

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena, saving for the last day the most difficult intention of all, the lukewarm and indifferent of whom He said:

"These souls cause Me more suffering than any others; it was from such souls that My soul felt the most revulsion in the Garden of Olives. It was on their account that I said: 'My father, if it is possible, let this cup pass Me by.' The last hope of salvation for them is to flee to My Mercy."

In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her: "On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy...On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls."

The different souls prayed for on each day of the novena are:

- Day 1** (Good Friday) - All mankind, especially sinners
 - Day 2** (Holy Saturday) - The souls of priest and religious
 - Day 3** (Easter Sunday) - All devout and faithful souls
 - Day 4** (Easter Monday) - Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know him
 - Day 5** (Easter Tuesday) - The souls of separated brethren
 - Day 6** (Easter Wednesday) - The meek and humble souls and the souls of children
 - Day 7** (Easter Thursday) - The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy
 - Day 8** (Easter Friday) - The souls who are detained in purgatory
 - Day 9** (Easter Saturday) - The souls who have become lukewarm.
- During the Solemn Novena leading to Divine Mercy Sunday, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy should be offered each day for the day's intentions.
