SEEING IS BELIEVING

Seeing is believing! Since cellphone screens connect us instantly to social media, live TV, and loved ones' faces near and far, "Doubting Thomas" could be our patron saint: "Unless I see, I will not believe!" But how comforting for any of us who share Thomas's doubt, or love "doubters" who do, to see how kindly Jesus responds. By offering the very evidence that Thomas demanded, Jesus doesn't scold Thomas, but seems to understand such skepticism. Could Jesus have been thinking of us, who long to believe that "Jesus is risen!" but see so much suffering, and perhaps even cause some, that we wonder, how could something so wonderful be true? In today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the risen Jesus' healing love comforts through disciples who love others. How to pray the Devine Mercy Chaplet:

Step 1 - Using a regular set of Rosary beads, you begin at the cross by doing the sign of the cross.
 (Repeat three times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

Step 2 - On the three beads of the rosary pray the Our Father, the Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.

Step 3 - You begin each decade with the Our Father beads by praying this prayer:
 Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

Step 4 - Complete the decade on the 10 Hail Mary beads by praying this prayer:
 For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
 Repeat Steps 3 and 4 for each decade on the rosary beads.

Step 5 - Once you have prayed all 5 decades, you finish the Chaplet by praying the following prayer 3 times:
 Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. Amen.



Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!

Easter Sunday is supposed to be a day of joyous celebration. Unfortunately, for many of our brothers and sisters in faith in Sri Lanka it was a day of mourning.

In most Sunday schools, the question is an academic exercise. "How many of you are willing to die for Christ?" asked the teacher on Easter morning. Every one of the children dutifully raised their hands.

A few minutes later, the Sri Lankan class descended to Zion Church's main service, passing through an outside courtyard where a stranger was speaking with church leaders. He had discovered there was no Easter morning Mass at the nearby Catholic church in Batticaloa, and was wondering when the service would begin.

Observers report he was sweating profusely. A pastor invited him to take off his backpack. Then, an explosion. Half the children died on the spot.

"All the children had responded [to their teacher's question] by putting their hands up, and signaled their fresh dedication to Jesus by lighting a symbolic candle," recounts a seminary leader. "For so many of those children, it would be their final act of worship." from christianitytoday.com

Below is our Bishop's statement:

"Along with the rest of the world, I learned this morning of the shocking and cruel terror attacks in Sri Lanka. Easter Sunday is our most holy day, a joyful day that has turned to tears for the innocents who have been injured and killed. These deliberate assaults were not just against our brothers and sisters but on everyone who values life, love, and peace. Together with Pope Francis, and on behalf of the faithful of the Diocese of London, I condemn these acts of hatred and express our sorrow for the victims and their families. "These attacks were made on Easter Sunday, the day we proclaim Christ's victory over death and sin. Let us join in prayer with all believers and people of good will, asking God to deliver us from every evil. May God grant peace in our days, and may we redouble our efforts to live out Christ's commandment to love one another as He loved us."

National Day of Prayer for Palliative Care

At 9:30am there will be the Holy Rosary; 12:10 Mass as usual; 2pm - The Physicians Way of the Cross; 3pm – Devine Mercy Chaplet concluded with Benediction.

New responses - With the new Liturgical Season, we are going back to the First Penitential Act *I confess...* and the first response in the Eucharistic Prayer: *We proclaim your...*

Divine Mercy Sunday - Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when "all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened". (Diary 699) Our Lord made a great promise to all those souls who would go to Confession and then receive Him in Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy, on the Sunday after Easter, which is now called Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Catholic Church.

Jesus promised that "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary 699) He went on to say "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy." (Diary 1109)

We want to encourage everyone to take advantage of this incredible promise and the additional Plenary Indulgence on this great Feast of Mercy "Divine Mercy Sunday". We want you to benefit fully from these promises, and we also want you to notify all of your family and friends about them! Join us for the Divine Mercy celebrations at St. Michael's Church, Bright's Grove, today at 2pm.
