"I am going fishing." What an announcement! If asked who made it, and not told it was a Bible quote, we might guess "Grandpa" or "Uncle Fred," or admit, "I said that last summer!" But it is a Bible quote, from today's Gospel. The person who said it also once declared, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Yes, it's Peter! So today's announcement seems quite the comedown. Last Sunday Jesus said, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." But Peter seems determined to return to his pre-apostolic occupation, until Jesus intervenes, making Peter's later announcement deeper, "Lord, you know that I love you," and Peter's apostolic calling clearer, "Tend my sheep." Peter does so. Acts presents the consequences: Peter declares, "We must obey God rather than men." Dear sisters and brothers in Christ, we do not like changes, but some are necessary in our life. We look forward to them, like the change of seasons and the summer we are waiting for. There is a change that is going to happen in our parish at the beginning of July, a new Parish Administrator and a new Parochial Vicar will join our community. Fr. Brian Jane will come from St. John the Baptist Parish in Amherstburg to serve together with Fr. Anthony Eboh from Sacred Heart/St. Michael in Sarnia, as his associate. Fr. Ray will join the Sacred Heart/St. Michael Cluster and I will be back with the Michaelite Fathers community with a new assignment, not yet determined.

Dear Parishioners, it has been a great joy to be with you. I am not saying goodbye yet, but I want you to know, that I will treasure this time together deep in my heart.

As you may know, I will be going away on a Pilgrimage to Europe May 13-27. If you have any mass intentions you would like me to take, please leave them at the parish office. I will keep you in my prayers while visiting the shrines of Europe.

Our **Cluster Parish Picnic** will take place next month, **Sunday, June 23rd at Canatara Park**. I want to thank all those who have joined our volunteer group so far. We are still looking for more volunteers who can help us with the preparations for this event. Our **planning meeting is on Monday, May 6th at 7pm at OLM Hall**. If you want to help us out in other ways, we are also looking for prizes for our Picnic Draw: such as: gift cards, gift baskets, business vouchers, etc. Please bring them to the parish office before June 14th.

May, the month in which the earth springs into bloom and we start thinking about planting gardens, family picnics, and making vacation plans. It's also **the Month of Mary**. Why? For centuries, the Catholic Church has set aside the entire month of Mary to honor Mary, the Mother of God. Not just a day in May, mind you, but the entire month. The idea of a month dedicated specifically to Mary can be traced back to baroque times. Although it wasn't always held during May, Mary Month included thirty daily spiritual exercises honoring Mary. It was in this era that Mary's Month and May were combined, making May the Month of Mary with special devotions organized on each day throughout the month. This custom became especially widespread during the nineteenth century and remains in practice until today.

Catholic Education Week 2019 begins on Sunday, May 5. The Catholic schools in our parish will engage in a series of events to celebrate the ongoing gift of Catholic education. Catholic Graduate Expectations challenge students to articulate in society those fundamental values that underpin Catholic education. This year's theme is "Living as Joyful Disciples." It's common for parishes to have a **Rosary during May**, and many erect a special May altar with a statue or picture of Mary as a reminder of Mary's month. Additionally, it's a long-standing tradition to crown the statue of Mary during May. Often, the crown is made of beautiful blossoms representing Mary's beauty and virtue. It's also a reminder to the faithful to strive to imitate our Blessed Mother's virtue in our own lives.

But May altars and crownings aren't just "church" things. We can and should be doing the same in our homes. When we echo the customs and traditions of the Church in our homes – our domestic churches – we participate more fully in the life of the Church.

If you haven't already, I encourage you to erect a prayer corner in your home. No matter how fancy or simple it is. The main point is that it's a place designated for God, and more specifically, for spending time with him. Just as you need proper atmosphere to sleep, you also need proper atmosphere to pray.

Parish project update...

Our Lady of Mercy...

- The new washroom in the back is almost finished but is already open for use.
