RECONCILED DIVERSITY

A few years ago, during Rome's quiet summer, Pope Francis took a day off to visit privately with some old friends, whose identity took Catholic Italy by surprise: Evangelical Protestants. They welcomed Francis to their Pentecostal Church of Reconciliation, where Francis asked pardon for Catholic persecutions and celebrated the Holy Spirit's "pentecostal work." Unlike Satan, declared Francis, who creates division among God's children, the Holy Spirit creates a diversity rich and beautiful. And unity; not uniformity, Francis specified, but unity in diversity. Francis named the Spirit's gift "reconciled diversity." Pentecost's rich treasury of scriptural readings, for Saturday's vigil and Sunday's morning liturgy, traces the Holy Spirit's work from creation's beginning, through Jesus' resurrection, into the church's earliest days, now into our days. Kindled in our hearts, the Spirit's gentle fire is ours to share generously, even with those most strikingly different from us. All hearts are Spirit-warmed by reconciled diversity.

Our life is made up of multiple experiences. Joys and troubles, successes and failures, are woven together in our daily life, animating or weighing us down. But often we are hardly aware of what's deepest in our own selves.

What we grasp in our self-awareness is just a small island amid the wide and deep sea that is life.

In his precious book *Spiritual Experience*, Karl Rahner invites us to consider the inmost "experience" that occurs within us, though often unperceived: the living presence of God's Spirit who works from within. This experience can easily be overwhelmed by many others that occupy our time and attention. It is a quiet presence that can be drowned out by other worries that take hold of our heart.

Mostly, we seem to think that what's great and gratuitous must be something rare, but God's grace is not like that. There's a tendency to consider the living presence of the Spirit as something reserved to chosen and select people. But God's Spirit is always alive in the human heart.

The Spirit is there, wherever life is and the duties of each day are carried out. God's Spirit works silently in the heart of regular and simple people.

Pentecost invites us to seek that presence of God's Spirit in our own selves, not to imagine it as a trophy granted only to the elite. We need to welcome the Spirit of God who is the font of all life. This Spirit is for everyone, because the immense Love of God is present to all the joys and groans, efforts and yearnings that spring from the heart of all God's children. This Sunday we begin a special "Year of Prayer" to ask for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on our diocese as we seek to become a mission-oriented Church that forms disciples of Jesus.

There is new development in the Our Lady of Mercy Renovation Project. On our joined Financial and Building Committees Meeting last week it was decided that we want to follow with the extension to the project. As usually in renovations on churches over 100 years old, we found new areas that had to be addressed: the additional brickwork; new crosses in place of old ones, that were beyond repair; proper roof to wall flashings. With the approval from Diocesan Office we will be able to proceed with this work that will add 60 000 to the costs of the project.

Thank you for your support! We are still receiving new pledges for our Capital Campaign, that will support extensive work at Our Lady of Mercy Church. Only last week we received a new pledge for an additional 150,000 dollars!!!

Dear brothers and sisters,

We invite you to celebrate with us the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel at the Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary in Merlin on Tuesday, July 16, 2019. The day will begin with lunch at 12:00 pm and a Praise & Worship concert featuring the Wallaceburg Life Teen Band. A rosary Procession will then take place at 1:30 pm, followed by the celebration of Mass and benediction at 2:00pm. Parishes are encouraged to organize a pilgrimage to this celebration.

You are also invited to join us on July 16th for a walking pilgrimage to the Shrine. There will be three starting points for the walking pilgrimage; a 22 kilometre walk will depart from St. Ursula Church in Chatham at 7:00 am, a 10 kilometre walk will depart from the North Buxton Museum at 10:00 am, and a 4 kilometre walk will depart from the Merlin Community Hall at 10:00 am. The Merlin group will walk at a modest pace more suitable for pilgrims with mobility concerns. Parishes are encouraged to organize a car or bus pool of pilgrims and join one of the departure locations. Pilgrims arriving by car will be able to park their vehicles at these locations, and volunteers will be available after the day's celebrations to drive pilgrims back to the parking lots. A diocesan representative will be at each of the departure locations and will lead pilgrims to the Shrine. Pilgrims are welcome to bring their own lunches, or purchase a hamburger or hotdog from the Knights of Columbus for a small fee. It is not necessary to register for this celebration.

A pilgrimage encourages everyone to become missionary disciples with us, and to invite their family, friends and neighbours to pray together in this year dedicated to prayer in our diocese, to deepen their faith and their relationship with the Lord.
