The **Espiritu Santo (Holy Spirit) Festival** this year will be celebrated on July 7th. We will begin with 12:30pm Mass at St. Joseph's Church followed by reception at the Portuguese Club.

There is some unfortunate news regarding St. Benedict's parking lot: last week an unknown person had a car failure and parked the car on our church parking lot. The failure ended up with a huge gasoline leak. We were not informed about it and received the information the day after from a neighbour. The gasoline has destroyed the surface of our parking lot and unfortunately is still doing the damage underneath. We are in contact with the paving company to find solutions to avoid any additional damage and ways to repair the parking lot.

The bell structure at St. Joseph is getting the guards and bell and should be put inside in a matter of days. The beautification process will continue after.

We are in need for continuous prayer in our lives. One great way is to adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in our Sarnia Deanery Adoration Chapel, located at Our Lady of Mercy Church. Not only will you join other parishioners but many saints in a special way present in their relics.

St. Benedict (born 480 – died 547), founder of the Benedictine monastery at Monte Cassino and father of Western monasticism; the rule that he established became the norm for monastic living throughout Europe. In 1964, in view of the work of monks following the Benedictine Rule in the evangelization and civilization of so many European countries in the Middle Ages, Pope Paul VI proclaimed him the patron saint of all Europe. *Biographies from: Catholic.org and Britannica.com*

St. Francisco Marto (June 11, 1908 - April 4, 1919) and his sister **St. Jacinta Marto** (March 11, 1910 - February 20, 1920), together with their cousin, Lúcia dos Santos (1907-2005) were the children from Aljustrel near Fátima, Portugal, who said they witnessed three apparitions of an angel in 1916 and several apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 1917. Lucia (aged 9) and her cousins Francisco and Jacinta Marto (aged 8 and 6, respectively) were tending sheep in central Portugal in 1917 when they had a vision of a woman surrounded by light who identified herself as the Lady of the Rosary. She exhorted them to pray the rosary for world peace and, over the course of her six apparitions, gave the children three "secrets." After initially questioning the authenticity of the children's visions, the Vatican accepted them as appearances of the Virgin Mary (Our Lady of the Holy Rosary of Fátima), and Fátima became the location of one of the greatest Marian shrines in the world. They were beatified on May 13, 2000 in Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary in Fatima, Portugal, by Pope John Paul II and canonized on May 13th, 2017 by Pope Francis.

St. Maria Goretti (October 16, 1890 – July 6, 1902) is an Italian virgin-martyr and one of the youngest canonized saints. She was born to a farming family. Her father died when she was nine, and they had to share a house with another family, the Serenellis. Maria took over household duties while her mother, brothers, and sister worked in the fields. One afternoon, Alessandro, the Serenellis' twenty-year-old son, made sexual advances to her. When she refused to submit to him, he stabbed her fourteen times. She was taken to the hospital, but she died forgiving him. He was arrested, convicted, and jailed. During imprisonment he repented. After 27 years he was released from prison, and visited her mother to beg forgiveness, which she granted. He later became a lay brother in a monastery, dying peacefully in 1970. She was beatified in 1947 and canonized in 1950. She is especially venerated in the Congregation of the Passion.

Bl. Bronisław Markiewicz. (July 13, 1842 – January 29, 1912) He was a priest of the Przemyśl Diocese (south-eastern Poland), and was a revered churchman recognized for his spirit of sacrifice. From the very beginning of his priestly life, he was particularly sensitive towards the religious, moral, and material negligence of children and youth and to the misery of simple people. In his opinion the solution of social problems depended upon the proper education of young people and on changing the moral climate of the whole society. Following a Divine inspiration, he went to Italy and became a follower of Saint John Bosco. After seven years, in 1892, he returned to Poland and was put in charge of the parish in Miejsce Piastowe in Poland. In addition to his pastoral work, he provided a widespread educational system. He soon thought of founding a new religious congregation. On 23rd September 1923, he petitioned the Bishop of Przemyśl and the Pope to allow him to found the Congregation of St. Michael the Archangel. Father Markiewicz did not live to witness its approval. On 29th September 1921 Bishop of Krakow issued the Erecting Decree of the Congregation. The beatification took place in Warsaw on June 19, 2005.

St. Pope Pius X (June 2, 1835 - August 20, 1914) born Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto. Two of the most outstanding accomplishments of this saintly Pope were the inauguration of the liturgical renewal and the restoration of frequent communion from childhood. He also waged an unwavering war against the heresy and evils of Modernism, gave great impetus to biblical studies, and brought about the codification of Canon Law. His overriding concern was to renew all things in Christ. Above all, his holiness shone forth conspicuously. From St. Pius X we learn again that "the folly of the Cross", simplicity of life, and humility of heart are still the highest wisdom and the indispensable conditions of a perfect Christian life, for they are the very source of all apostolic fruitfulness. He was canonized on May 29, 1954.

Bl. Pope Pius IX (May 13, 1792 – February 7, 1878), born Giovanni Maria Mastai-Ferretti, was the longest-reigning elected Pope in the history of the Catholic Church, serving from 16 June 1846 until his death, a period of nearly 32 years. During his pontificate, he convened the First Vatican Council in 1869, which decreed papal infallibility. The Pope defined the dogma of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, meaning that Mary was conceived without original sin. Pius IX also granted the Marian title of Our Mother of Perpetual Help, a famous Byzantine icon from Crete entrusted to the Redemptorist priests. In addition to this, Pius IX was also the last Pope to rule as the Sovereign of the Papal States, which fell completely to Italian nationalist armies by 1870 and were incorporated into the Kingdom of Italy. He was beatified in 2000.

St. Simon the Apostle, one of the Twelve Apostles. In the Gospels of Mark and Matthew, he bears the epithet the Cananaean, often wrongly interpreted to mean "from Cana" or "from Canaan." Kananaïos is the Greek transliteration of an Aramaic word, qan' anaya, meaning "the Zealot," the title given him by Luke in his Gospel and in Acts. He preached the Gospel in Egypt and then joined the apostle St. Judas (Thaddaeus) in Persia, where, according to the apocryphal Acts of Simon and Judas, he was martyred by being cut in half with a saw, one of his chief iconographic symbols (another being a book).

St. Francis Xavier (April 7, 1506 – December 3, 1552) the greatest Roman Catholic missionary of modern times who was instrumental in the establishment of Christianity in India, the Malay Archipelago, and Japan. In Paris in 1534 he pronounced vows as one of the first seven members of the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits, under the leadership of St. Ignatius of Loyola. He is credited for his idea that the missionary must adapt to the customs and language of the people he evangelizes, and for his advocacy of an educated native clergy. He always provided for the continuing pastoral care of the communities he founded and did not abandon them after baptism. The areas he evangelized in India have remained Catholic to the present day. Vigorous and prolonged persecution in the 17th century did destroy the missions he founded in the Moluccas and Japan but only after thousands had died as martyrs. Even before his death, Francis Xavier was considered a saint, and he has been formally venerated as such by the Catholic Church since 1622. In 1927 he was named patron of all missions.
